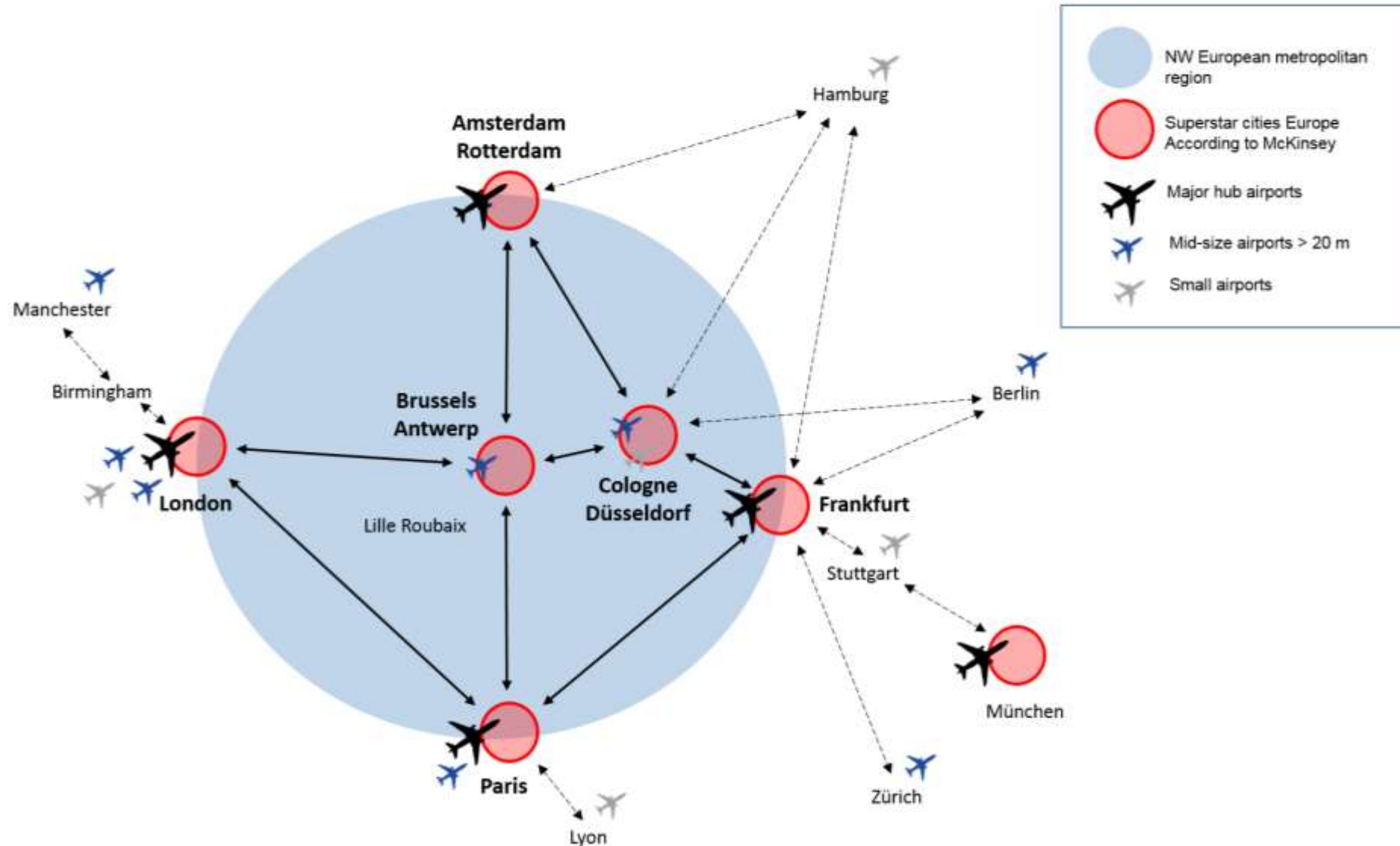

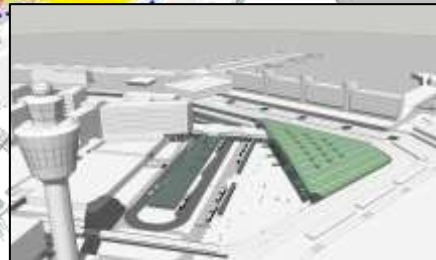
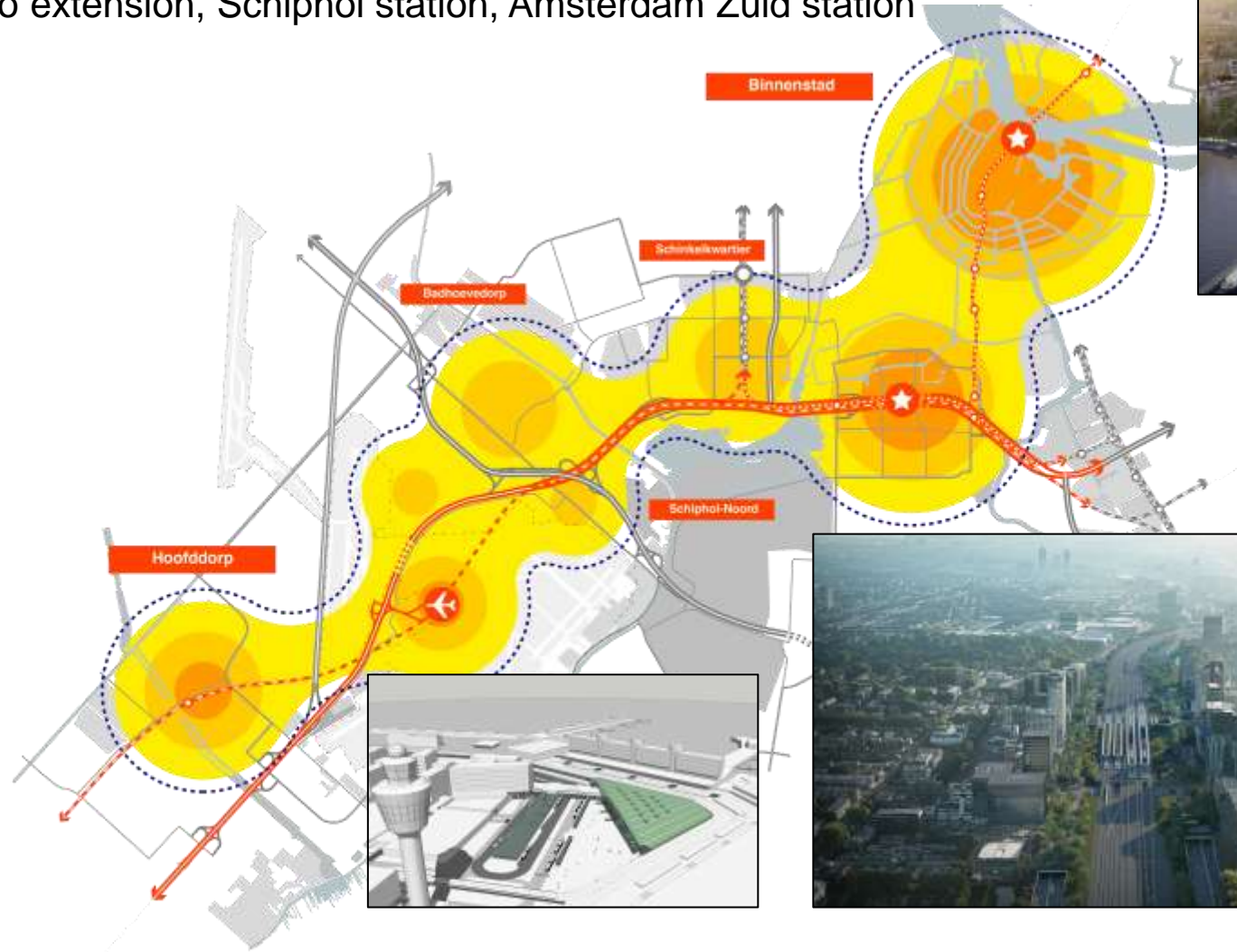
Coherent system of airports and high speed train stations
